

Introduction

Malaysia Airlines operated its first flight with fare paying passengers in 1947 with one twin engine Airspeed Consul plane that seated five passengers, and has since grown to become an award-winning airline with a fleet of over 100 aircraft servicing over 100 destinations across six continents.

Malaysia Airlines in Australia

Malaysia Airlines is the fourth largest foreign carrier in Australia and operates 47 flights weekly from five cities in Australia - Sydney, Melbourne, Perth, Brisbane and Adelaide.

Fleet

Malaysia Airlines (airline code MH) has a total of 111 aircraft in its fleet.

These include (as at 01 Feb 06); 39 **B737-400**; 17 **B747-400**; 17 **B777-200**; 11 **A330-300**; 8 **B747-200 (Freighter)**; 9 **F50**; 5 **DHC6**; and 5 **A330-200s**.

Onboard

MH offers 3 classes of service onboard its aircraft; First Class, Golden Club Class and Economy Class.

All of the carrier's B747-400s and B777s have fully integrated in-seat entertainment systems in all classes offering a selection of latest release movies, interactive electronic games and music channels.

Enrich Frequent Flyer Program

Enrich is MH's frequent flyer program which allows members the ability to accrue *Enrich Miles* on its services, other Enrich Airline Partners' flights, or when using the services of its other non-air partners including hotels and car rental firms.

The points can be then be redeemed for free MH flights, upgrades to Golden Club or First Class, or

for free in-flight shopping.

There are four tiers to the Enrich program, Blue, Silver, Gold or Platinum with differing benefits for each tier.

Golden Lounges

When checking in, First and Golden Club Class passengers and Enrich Gold Members are able to enter the Malaysia Airlines' *Golden Lounge*.

There are two Golden Lounges at Kuala Lumpur International Airport; the *Golden Lounge Satellite* in the Satellite Building, which caters to international travellers; and the *Golden Lounge Domestic* at the Contact Pier for domestic travellers.

The Golden Lounge Satellite is one of the largest privileged passenger facilities in the world and has a business centre with meeting rooms, massage chairs, and offers a wide range of food and beverages.

Golden Holidays

Golden Holidays by Malaysia Airlines combines MH fares with luxury holiday packages to some of Malaysia's most acclaimed five star resorts including the *Nexus Resort, Kota Kinabalu* and the *Four Seasons Resort, Langkawi Island*.
